SEPARATION OF THE JOINED SETTLEMENTS

As we continue to strive for greater data accuracy and actionable insights, we're excited to announce an important development in our data refinement efforts. We have separated the names of Oruchinga and Nakivale settlements.



Previously, refugee settlements, such as Oruchinga and Nakivale, have been grouped together in our data systems. While this approach has been functional, it has sometimes obscured valuable nuances and trends within these individual settlements. This change will make it easier for you to navigate and find the information you need.



In the coming weeks, we'll be implementing the same separation for Rhinocamp and Imvepi. This will further enhance the app's user experience and make it even more efficient to use.



RESTORING VHT ACCESS

We recently completed a system upgrade to enhance the functionality and security of our platform. While this upgrade was intended to improve your experience, we understand that some users, particularly Village Health Teams (VHTs), have encountered unexpected issues.

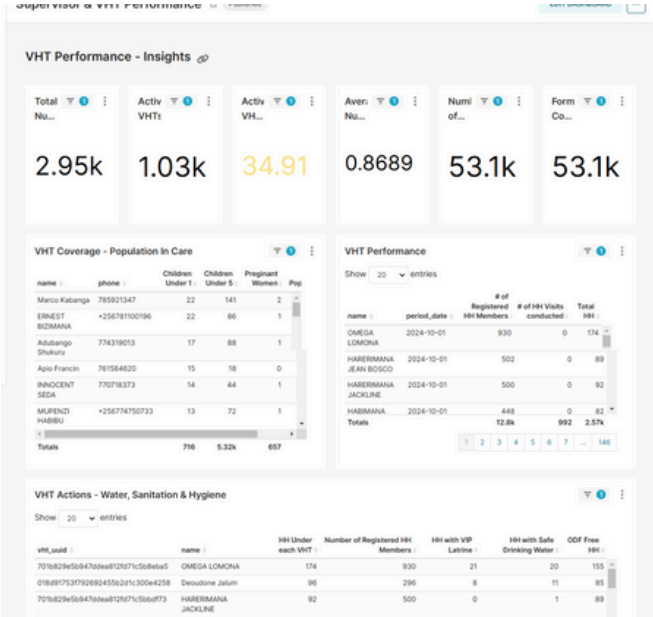
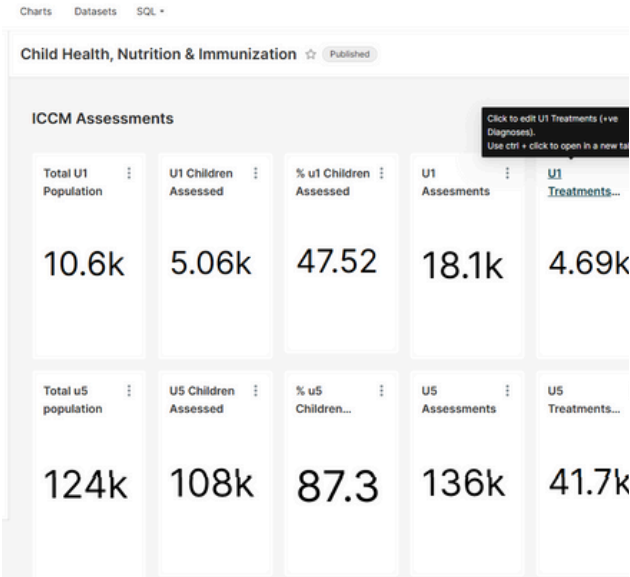
A number of VHTs have reported being automatically logged out of the system. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused.
